Successful Community Projects

Recently we completed the Ashfield Gardens Project, in partnership with Groundwork and Omagh District Council. Two sandstone monuments were created to mark the entrance to the regenerated Ashfield Garden Estate. A number of residents were involved in the construction, and engraving of the entrances through training provided at Mullaghmore including Health & Safety training. The residents assisted with the design, and simultaneously acquired new skills within the practical bases environment on wall contractions and stone lettering. Residents took ownership of the monument taking pride in their work and developing the area around it.



Another example of the versatility of the facilities at Mullaghmore is the Tyrone Donegal Partnership glass painting and card art class specifically for students with learning disabilities. The aim of the course was to bring people together from various communities and backgrounds to learn to value each others diverse qualities within our local area.



The group learned practical skills in glass painting, design, and left with a final piece of work.

Other community courses have been made in conjunction with Omagh College and such organisations as Manchester University of Arts and technology. With Omagh College students were invited to ‘Unlock the Artisan’, open to joinery students giving them a unique opportunity to work practically on original pieces of furniture, and within the joinery trade. Specialist Cabinet Making, Furniture building, and design and marketing were just some of the skills ascertained, as part of this business based training.

Manchester University students have studied at Mullaghmore in conjunction with their honours Degree Course in ‘Restoration & Conservation’. Again they were given the opportunity to learn practical hands on skills in a genuine established business environment.

Community Groups

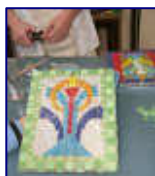

Course Content

NIOCN Level 1:Interior Design for the home (20hours)

The learner will look at aspects to consider when re-designing a room space, how to use soft furnishings, window dressings, wall and floor finishes, furniture, lighting and finishing touches to achieve a desired look, how to create a variety of simple but effective paint techniques for use around the home. The learner also looks at aspects of different room spaces such as bedrooms and living spaces.

NIOCN Level 2:Interior Design - Materials and professional services (30hours)

The learner will look at design briefs and how to produce a full specification for a given interior design brief, how to obtain quotations for materials, finishes and products, look at what information is required before you can obtain quotations, how to research suppliers / contractors etc. look at product / material specification and their presentation.

NIOCN Level 3:Professional Client design Brief (60hours)

Note: Students work with live clients for this level (depending on availability). The learner will recognise how to conduct a professional meeting with a client and develop a design brief, research and record styles / trends appropriate to brief, learn how to develop suitable design layouts to produce working drawings and design plans for brief and illustrate how to order and convey information to a client in a professional manner, look at one point perspective drawings in order to produce a coloured visual drawing of an interior design scheme, understand how to produce a design specification and costing within a budget, recognise how to evaluate the design presentation to the client. Within this course we include a section on setting up a business (5 hours in total) The learner will look at what is involved in setting up a business, how to create a business plan, and marketing
